The Tumaini Fund support over 100,000 orphans and widows in Kagera, North West Tanzania. Care is provided by a dedicated team of Parish Workers.

Our vision, in Tumaini Scotland, is to find support for 200 Parish Workers who serve the orphans and widows in their own communities.

Each Parish Worker is supported for £20 per month. If you are interested in partnering to bring hope in this way, please see overleaf for more information.

Introducing our Parish workers

Parish Workers support Tumaini families often in several villages at a time. They work in pairs, usually one male and one female, and may support over 120 orphans each. They are provided with a bicycle to enable them to visit families living remotely, monitor their health, support school attendance, and offer other practical and psychological support.



Parish Workers encourage all Tumaini-supported widows and orphans to be tested for HIV and support them to access retroviral medication.

As the work expands and develops into new areas, The Tumaini Fund employs new workers who have local knowledge and can highlight families of concern to Tumaini's Social Workers and Co-ordinators. These brothers and sisters are the 'hands and feet' of Tumaini.
